After a career in art of over twenty years, in 2018 she had her first ever solo show in the Canaries, Show Me (TEA Tenerife Espacio de las Artes), the first in a trilogy of exhibitions which concludes in 2019 with her projects Know Us, for Centro Atlántico de Arte Moderno-CAAM, and Welcome Her in Casa África.
